- On the left side of the page you will see "Adult learning dates"
- Click on "Sign up for Learning Dates"
- Step 1 Type: Adult Training as the registration type.

Leadership Essentials-Classroom Session

Description: Leadership Essentials is a session that will help prepare you to effectively facilitate the Girl Scout Leadership Experience (GSLE). This session offers flexibility, so it can be used with volunteers working with any grade-level. We will discuss the GSLE, Outcomes and Indicators, using the adult guide and girl book for the Journeys, integrating traditional materials with the Journeys, troop management tools, and purposeful leadership. Please bring: paper, pen, Safety-Wise, and Journeys, if you have them. If you're staying all day for training, you may want to bring a sack lunch and beverage.

Who Should Attend: All new leaders, co-leaders, assistant leaders, advisors, co-advisors or assistant advisors, anyone needing information on the Girl Scout Leadership Experience and the Journeys.

Time: three hours

Leadership Essentials Online

Description: Leadership Essentials Online is interchangeable with the face-to-face version of Leadership Essentials, so volunteers can choose to use one or the other as they prepare to partner with girls. Either version of Leadership Essentials will help volunteers gain a good understanding of the journey resources available to them, as well as a refresher of the fundamentals of the GSLE. Leadership Essentials Online is available 24/7 so you can engage in this learning session at own convenience. Girl Scouts of Central Indiana provides facilitator coaches to support your learning experience.

Who Should Attend: All new leaders, co-leaders, assistant leaders, advisors, co-advisors or assistant advisors, anyone needing information on the Girl Scout Leadership Experience and the Journeys.

Time: 45-60 minutes

Journeys Plus

Who Should Attend: Experienced leaders, co-leaders, assistant leaders, advisors, co-advisors or assistant advisors who have not taken Leadership Essentials; troops bridging to the next level; anyone needing detailed information on the Journeys.

Fee: None

Time: 90 minutes

Description: Journeys Plus is a more detailed look at the Girl Scout Leadership Experience, working with the Journeys, and integrating traditional materials with the Journeys. This session offers flexibility, so it can be used with volunteers working with any grade-level. It can be broken into half-hour modules and presented at a Service Unit Meeting. Please bring: paper, pen, Safety-Wise, and Journeys, if you have them.

Description: Girl Scouts of Central Indiana Orientation is a one hour session designed for all volunteers to attend. It will help volunteers to understand policies, practices, forms, procedures and information that is specific to our local council. Please bring: paper, pen, Safety-Wise.

GSUSA Online Orientation

Who Should Attend: Anyone new to Girl Scouting, potential volunteers, community members.

Fee: None

Time: 20-40 minutes

Description: This online home-study contains information on the history of Girl Scouts, the Girl Scout Leadership Experience program, and different Pathways for girls and adults to participate.

To login: <http://training.girlscouts.org>. The password is all lowercase, "discover" for English and "descubrir" por español. Once you enter the password, it takes about 90 seconds for the first video clip to load. When it's done playing, click on the link for "Learning Log." This is how the computer will keep track of your answers, and send a copy to GSCI at the end. In the box for E-mail address, put your e-mail address, then a semi-colon, then my e-mail address. It should turn out like this:

Click on "Continue" and then go through the presentation by clicking on the arrows. If you get to a blank page, wait for a minute - it might be loading another video. Otherwise, you can always click on the Table of Contents button and find the next section.
