### **Appreciation Pin Award Nomination Guidelines**

This awarded recognition is submitted to the council Volunteer Services Department and approved by the council board of directors. Nomination forms and letters must be submitted together to the Volunteer Services Department by February 9. This award recognizes an adult member who has delivered outstanding service to at least one service unit in a way that impacts the council's goals and objectives. Examples of appropriate nominees include, but are not limited to the following:

- A volunteer who has recruited others to lead troops or serve as mentors to under-represented populations.
- A volunteer who has increased participation in the family campaign program impacting the financial goals of the council.
- A service unit manager who has increased membership in excess of goal.

#### **Criteria**

1. The nominee is a registered Girl Scout adult.
2. The nominee has provided outstanding service to at least one service unit in a way that furthers the council's goals and objectives.
3. The nominee's service has exceeded expectations of their position.

#### **Nomination**

Individuals or troops/groups familiar with the nominee's performance submits a nomination form accompanied by three letters of endorsement. Letters must be written by someone other than the nominator and must demonstrate the nominee's accomplishments. The nomination must quantify and outline the scope and impact on the council. The Volunteer Services Department will notify the nominator when the award is approved or denied.
