### **Honor Pin Award Nomination Guidelines**

This awarded recognition is submitted to the council Volunteer Services Department and approved by the council board of directors. Nomination forms and letters must be submitted together to the Volunteer Services Department by February 9. This award recognizes an adult member who has delivered outstanding service to two or more service units in a way that impacts the council's goals and objectives. Examples of appropriate nominees include, but are not limited to the following:

- A unit leader of a successful day camp that includes multiple areas.
- A volunteer who implements a series of events and activities bringing girls from different parts of the council together.

#### **Criteria**

1. The nominee is a registered Girl Scout adult.
2. The nominee has provided outstanding service to two or more service units in a way that furthers the council's goals and objectives.
3. The nominee's service has exceeded expectations of their position.

#### **Nomination**

Individuals or troops/groups familiar with the nominee's performance submits a nomination form accompanied by three letters of endorsement. Letters must be written by someone other than the nominator and must demonstrate the nominee's accomplishments. The nomination must quantify and outline the scope and impact on the council. The Volunteer Services Department will notify the nominator when the award is approved or denied.
