Outstanding Leader Award Nomination Guidelines

This awarded recognition is approved at the service unit level and the approved name submitted to the council Volunteer Services Department. Nomination forms and letters of endorsement are to be submitted to the **Service Unit Team** by March 1. Girls/Parents can submit nomination forms and letters to Volunteer Services by March 1 if Service Unit Team contact is unknown. The Outstanding Leader Award recognizes a troop leader, assistant troop leader, or group leader whose performance in working with girls is outstanding.

Criteria

1. The nominee is a registered Girl Scout adult.
2. The nominee has demonstrated outstanding leadership, competence in girl-adult partnership, communication, membership development, pluralism, and program delivery.
3. The nominee's work with girls has exceeded expectations for their position.

Nomination

An individual or troop/group familiar with the nominee's performance submits a nomination form to the Service Unit, accompanied by two letters of endorsement. At least one letter is written by a girl and/or parent. The nomination and letters should demonstrate how the service performed has benefited girls and describe the outstanding leadership qualities of the nominee.

Approval

A committee appointed by the service unit team reviews the nomination, approves or denies the nomination, notifies the nominating individual or troop/group, and submits approved name to council Volunteer Services Department. Pins can then be purchased at the Showcase.
