Outstanding Volunteer Award
Nomination Guidelines

This awarded recognition is approved at the service unit level and the approved name submitted to the council Volunteer Services Department. Nomination forms and letters of endorsement are to be submitted to the Service Unit Team by March 1. The Outstanding Volunteer Award recognizes an adult volunteer in a position other than leader or in addition to leader whose service benefits the service unit in a way that is beyond the expectations for their position.

Criteria

1. The nominee is a registered Girl Scout adult.
2. The nominee has demonstrated competence for the position.
3. The nominee has performed at a level that exceeds the expectations of the position.

Nomination

An individual or troop/group familiar with the nominee's performance submits a nomination form accompanied by at least two letters of endorsement, written by someone other than the nominator, of the nominee's accomplishments to the Service Unit Team.

Approval

A committee appointed by the service unit team reviews the nomination, approves or denies the nomination, notifies the nominating individual or troop/group, and submits approved name to council Volunteer Services Department. Pins can then be purchased at the Showcase.
