Thanks Badge II Award Nomination Guidelines

This awarded recognition is submitted to the council Volunteer Services Department and approved by the council board of directors. Nomination forms and letters must be submitted together to the Volunteer Services Department by February 9. This award recognizes an adult member who has already received the Thanks Badge and who continues to contribute in significantly extraordinary ways that benefit the entire council or the entire Girl Scout movement. Examples of appropriate nominees include, but are not limited to the following:

- A board member whose leadership in fund development has resulted in greater financial stability for the council.
- A volunteer who initiates a support system that successfully impacts adult membership retention and is replicated in other councils.
- A volunteer who has served at the national level as a facilitator or committee member.

Criteria

1. The nominee is a registered Girl Scout adult.
2. The nominee has received the Thanks Badge.
3. The nominee has provided significant extraordinary service since receipt of the Thanks Badge by continuing to perform at the same high level for an extended period of time, increase her/his sphere of influence, or uses her/his skills and talents to broaden her/his scope of involvement.
4. The nominee's significantly extraordinary service benefits the council or entire Girl Scout movement.
5. The nominee's service is significantly extraordinary beyond expectations of their position.

Nomination

Individuals or troops/groups familiar with the nominee's performance submits a nomination form accompanied by four letters of endorsement. Letters must be written by someone other than the nominator and must demonstrate the nominee's accomplishments. The nomination must quantify and outline the scope and impact on the council or entire Girl Scout movement. The Volunteer Services Department will notify the nominator when the award is approved or denied.
